Our goal is to assist scouts in earning their badges while fostering a lifelong love for learning.

GIRL SCOUT BADGES

First Aid Badge: This badge class equips learners with the knowledge of how to seek assistance from emergency services like 911. It also covers how to handle minor injuries, guides on assembling a first aid kit, and provides information on preventing and treating outdoor injuries.

Babysitting Badge: This badge class is for kids aged 11+, offering training in basic childcare, first aid, developmental stages understanding, health and nutrition, sleep patterns, Heimlichmaneuver, EpiPen usage, and ad creation.

My Best Self Badge: This badge class guides learners in appreciating their unique features, understanding body organs, remembering major muscle groups through exercises, discussing healthy mood-boosting activities, and interviewing a health professional like an LMS instructor.

Pet Badge: This badge involves gaining knowledge about wild and domestic animals, understanding the differences in body language between dogs and cats, discerning the variances in their eating habits, and learning about the importance of exercise for dogs.

Brownie/Junior/Cadette STEM Career

Exploration Badges: These badges encourage exploration of various STEM careers, nurturing scientific curiosity and innovation.

Daisy Toy Business Designer Badge: This badge class guides learners in entrepreneurship through the process of designing, improving, and pitching a toy idea, emphasizing that entrepreneurship involves innovation, trial, and error.

Brownie Budding Entrepreneur Badge: This badge encourages girls to become entrepreneurs by coming up with an idea that enhances life quality. Kids will learn to share ideas with others to gain feedback and make necessary improvements.

Junior Business Jumpstart Badge: This badge programs involves creating a problem-solving prototype, garnering feedback, revising the prototype based on the feedback, formulating a persuasive pitch, and finally presenting your idea to an audience.

Cadette Business Creator Badge: Guides This badge programs entails devising an idea that addresses a specific problem, designing a prototype and soliciting feedback, revising the prototype based on the feedback, formulating a business plan, and finally, delivering your pitch.

Senior Business Startup Badge: This badge involves conceiving a business idea, designing and refining a prototype based on feedback, creating a business plan, and delivering a pitch.

Ambassador Entrepreneur Accelerator Badge:

This badge requires formulating a business idea, prototyping it, understanding the target market, validating the idea with market research, outlining operations via a business model, and finally pitching the business.
