To ensure a positive and safe experience for all students, we ask that all families read and acknowledge the following policies outlined in this packet.



STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

To help foster a respectful, safe, and engaging environment, students are expected to:

- Be kind and respectful to instructors and classmates
- Follow all classroom and program rules
- · Take care of materials and equipment provided
- Participate in activities to the best of their ability
- Refrain from behavior that is disruptive, harmful, or disrespectful

National Beneficies of the Beneficial Services (Section 1988) BEHAVIOR POLICY & DISMISSALS

Little Medical School® has a zero-tolerance policy for disrespectful, disruptive, or unsafe behavior. Students may be dismissed from the program for any of the following reasons (without refund of registration fees):

- Aggressive, threatening, or violent behavior
- · Repeated disruption of class or refusal to follow instructions
- Use of inappropriate language or gestures
- Damaging Little Medical School® or school property
- Bullying, teasing, or excluding other students
- · Behaviors are documented if they go against our policies and will be communicated to the parents of the student by the Program Director.
- Dismissal decisions are made at the discretion of the Program Director and instructors to ensure the safety and well-being of all students.



PAYMENT POLICY

Registration fees are required to secure a student's spot in the program.

- If you selected weekly payments, these are processed each Friday via Homeroom.
- If a weekly payment fails or is missed, families will receive a 1-week grace period to update their payment method.
- If payment is not received or caught up within 1 week, the student may be temporarily removed from the program until the account is brought current.
- Little Medical School® is unable to guarantee a spot will remain open if repeated payment attempts fail.



MISSED CLASSES

We understand that absences happen. While we cannot provide makeup classes, students will still receive any take-home items they missed and materials from missed lessons when possible.




TEACHING WITH FLORIDA'S STATE ACADEMIC STANDARDS FOR SCIENCE IN MIND
